After School Care Bills

All after school care bills are being sent home today in the green folder. Payments are due next Friday, January 18th. Please pay this bill or the program will no longer be available to you. If the bill is not paid in full, your child(ren) will not be allowed in after school care. If they are not allowed in the after school care program, please pick your child up on time from school. We dismiss at 3:00p.m.

Many families have outstanding balances. This must be paid whether or not your child is using the program. If you have any questions, please call the school at 464-5775.

Cold Weather

Remember to dress your children warmly. We go outdoors for recess whenever the temperature is above zero. Students need boots and snow pants to play in the snow. Boots are not worn in the classroom, so be sure to send a pair of shoes along. If you have extra snow pants or boots your child has outgrown, please consider donating them to the school for others to use outdoors. Please label all of your child(ren)'s item of clothing.

Emergency School Closings

Here is a reminder on the procedures for school closings. Watch TV or listen to the radio for school closings. If the entire Milwaukee Public School System is closed, we are also closed. There will also be an announcement that Blessed Savior School will be closed. That means all three campuses; South, East, and West. There may also be an announcement that the Milwaukee Archdiocese Schools are closed. This covers us as well. Watch channels 4, 6, or 12 on TV .

In the case of an individual campus closing for things like no heat, no electricity or other emergencies, the specific campus will be named.

Uniform Policy

Attached to this newsletter is our uniform policy. Please review what can and can not be worn to school each day as our dress code.

Really review the following:

- Sandals, flip flops, clogs, hiking or combat boots, shoes containing above a one inch heel, and **light-up shoes** are not permitted.
- Fingernails should be maintained in their natural state.
- Du-rags, bandanas or scarves are not allowed. **Head bands must be plain in design and not more than one inch wide.**
- Only Blessed Savior logo sweatshirts are allowed.
